

End User License Agreement (EULA)

This agreement is a legal contract between you (hereinafter referred to as 'User') and Ybroad.co (hereinafter referred to as 'Company'), governing the use of the software (hereinafter referred to as 'Software') provided by the Company. Please read this agreement carefully.

Article 1 (Purpose)

The purpose of this agreement is to define the conditions for using the software and services provided by the Company.

Article 2 (Grant of License)

1. The Company grants the User a non-exclusive, transferable license to use the Software purchased by the User.
2. This license is tied to the set-top box where the Software is initially installed and cannot be transferred to another set-top box or device.

Article 3 (Scope of License)

1. The User may use the Software only on the initially installed set-top box and cannot use it on other devices.
2. The User shall not modify, reverse engineer, decompile, or disassemble the Software.

Article 4 (Intellectual Property Rights)

1. All intellectual property rights in the Software belong to the Company, and no rights are granted to the User except for the license provided in this agreement.
2. The User shall not make or distribute copies of the Software and related documentation.

Article 5 (Termination of Agreement)

1. The Company may terminate the license if the User violates any conditions of this agreement.
2. Upon termination, the User must destroy all copies of the Software.

Article 6 (Limitation of Liability)

1. The Company is not liable for any direct, indirect, or incidental damages arising from the use of the Software.
2. The Company's total liability is limited to the amount paid by the User for the Software.

Article 7 (Miscellaneous)

1. This agreement is governed by the laws of the applicable country.
2. If any part of this agreement is found to be invalid, the remaining provisions will remain in effect.
